- Many other students

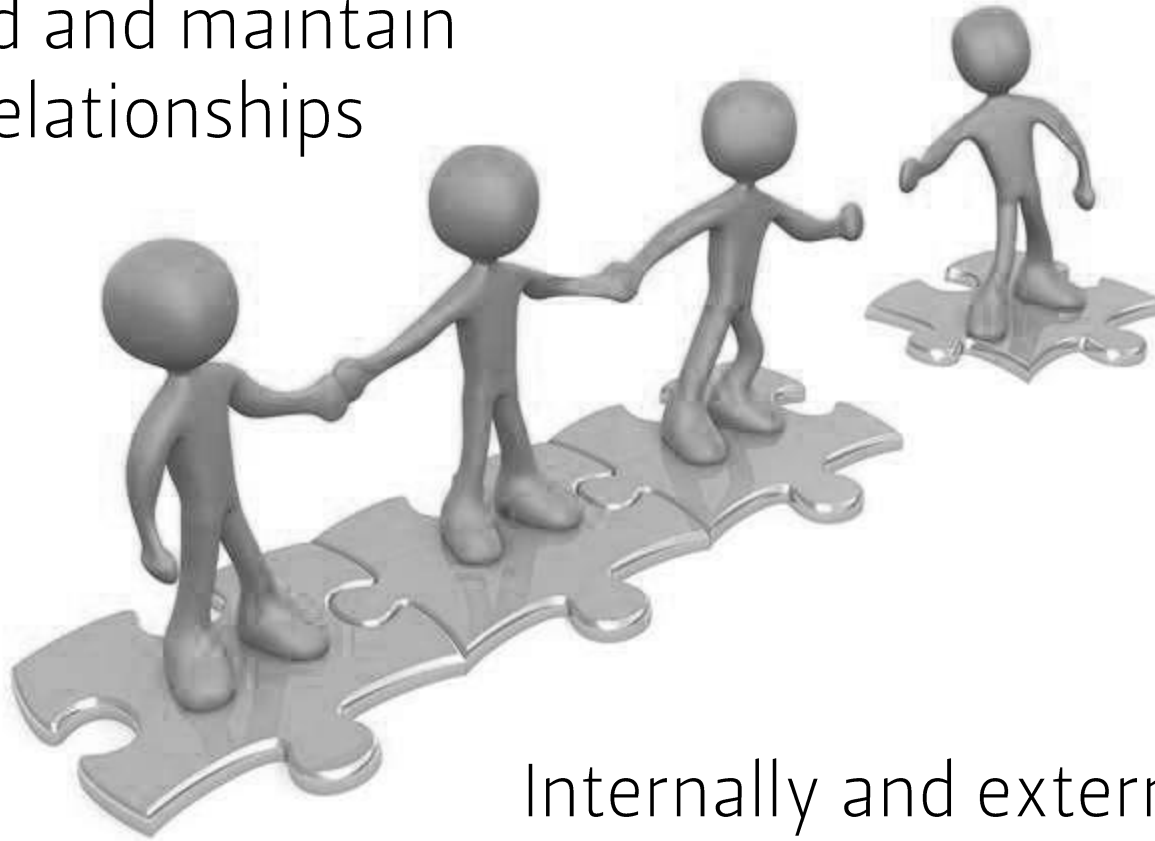
