  - See Academic Regulation 18 for more information about the S/U grade mode, which includes (but is not limited to):
    - Your instructor will not know if you chose an S/U grade mode for their course. If you receive a grade of C– or higher, the university will change your posted grade to an ‘S’ automatically. If you earn below a C–, the university will change your posted grade to a ‘U’ automatically.
    - The credit of courses in which an S grade is obtained shall be counted toward graduation. Credits shall not be awarded for U grades.
    - Students are limited to a maximum of 36 credits of S/U graded course work.
  - Academic Regulation 20 prohibits you from repeating a course on an S/U grading basis if previously taken with a normal A–F grading basis.
