Inactive GTA's and **Instructors**

Every term there are GTAs and instructors who are listed on courses who are no longer teaching.

They will remain active in Banner until they are removed from sections.

We have had more than one instance of where a section existed for an instructor who had retired, left the university and even passed away because the section copied over from year to year without being edited or removed.

It is the responsibility of the department to edit instructors in SYASECT, or in the case of 503/603 thesis sections, ask for those sections to be removed.

The schedule of classes only shows the primary instructor. To see all listed instructors, go to SYASECT in Banner.

Registration Restrictions 101

The Schedule Restrictions Form (**SSARRES**) is used by the schedule desk to create rules **at the section level** to restrict registration to certain student populations as requested by department schedulers.

Mixing different Restriction Categories can be tricky, be sure that the students you want to be able to register can fit into all of the intended categories.
