Veterans' Dependent Tuition Waiver Eligibility Information and Instructions

Admission	Student must be admitted to a degree program at Oregon State University.
Deadline	The Veterans' Dependent Tuition Waiver Application is due to the Veteran Certifying Official <u>no later than 14 days before</u> the term begins. Students previously receiving a similar tuition waiver at another college or university are still required to submit this OSU-specific waiver application.
Criteria	<p>In order to be eligible, students must meet one of two sets of criteria:</p> <p>1) The student must be a child (includes adopted child or stepchild) of a Purple Heart recipient, alive or deceased, who was relieved or discharged from service in the Armed Forces of the United States with either an honorable discharge or a general discharge under honorable conditions and was awarded the Purple Heart in 2001 or thereafter for wounds received in combat.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>2) The child (includes adopted child or stepchild), spouse, or un-remarried surviving spouse of a member of the United States Armed Forces who:</p> <p>a) Died while on active duty, or</p> <p>b) Died as a result of a military service-connected disability, or</p> <p>c) Is 100% disabled as the result of a military service-connected disability as certified by the Department of Veterans Affairs or any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States.</p> <p>(An eligible child must be 23 years of age or younger at the time the child applies for the waiver.)</p>
Degree Choice	A child who is older than 23 years of age is eligible for a waiver for a master's degree program if the child: 1) applied for and received a waiver for a baccalaureate degree when the child was 23 years of age or younger; and 2) applied for a master's program waiver within 12 months of receiving a baccalaureate degree.
Residency	The student must meet Oregon residency requirements as stipulated with OAR 580-010-0030 through 580-010-0045.
Award Amount	<p><u>This waiver is an OSU tuition waiver managed by the Office of Financial Aid.</u></p> <p>The maximum waiver granted under this program shall be: 1) The total number of attempted credit hours equal to four years of full-time attendance for a baccalaureate degree, and 2) the total number of attempted credit hours equal to two years of full-time attendance for a master's degree.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The waiver may not exceed the total number of credit hours the qualified student needs to graduate with a baccalaureate or a master's degree. Transferred credit hours accepted for a degree program may or may not count toward the total credit hours needed for degree completion. • The amount of tuition waived may be reduced by the amount of any federal aid scholarships or grants, awards from the Oregon Opportunity Grant program established under ORS 348.205, or any other aid from OSU. • This benefit does not apply to study abroad, self-support credits or to previously completed terms (waiver is not retroactive). • Funding will be reviewed and revised to match final tuition charges each term after all refund periods have ended. • <u>This waiver applies to tuition only</u>; all other fees related to each term are the financial responsibility of the student.
